	Christian Fenn: The Butterfly Effected CIC is seeking grant funding to facilitate a series of street art workshops within local schools in Fleetwood as an integral extension of the Big Heart Project.
	The amount asked for was £9500
	Continuing CF, said, the workshops (which will be held in various locations throughout Fleetwood) will provide an educational impact, continued public engagement with the Big Heart Project, along with enhancing mental health and well-being for over 200 school children in Fleetwood.

	CF advised that they would be looking to start, in conjunction with the Big-Hearted Project in August, moving into September.
	A discussion took place around the commitment that would be needed from CF that if there was any extra money was raised on top of the Crowd-Funding, must be spent in Fleetwood. CF confirmed and agreed.
	Spaces within the town that have been earmarked already, include Blakison Street and Mount Street.
	It was agreed collectively that the investment in Fleetwood's youth and in the public spaces is critical to the town's cultural and social vitality.
	To date, the Butterfly Effected CIC has successfully raised nearly $\$15,000$ through their Crowd-Funding campaign.
